

## TARS Scrapbook Competition

The scrapbook is to be 20"x20" or smaller Scrapbooks larger than 20"x20"	(10 points) (5 points)
The front cover of each scrapbook must show the name of the squad represented.	(0 or 10 points)
The scrapbook must be dated from Convention of the previous to present year. The date must be on the cover or front page of the scrapbook.	(0 or 10 points)
Can have any color scheme. It is up to the judges to determine how they like the color scheme.	(1 to 10 points)
Arrangement- Can be done in different ways. There is no set way to arrange. It is up to the judges to determine how they like the arrangement.	(1 to 10 points)
Neatness- It is up to the judges to determine if the scrapbook is put together in a neat manner.	(1 to 10 points)
Originality- It is up to the judges to determine if the scrapbook is put together in an original manner.	(1 to 10 points)
Newspaper Clippings 1 or more clippings No clippings	(10 points) (5 points)
All pages must have a written or typed explanation. One point will be deducted for every page not labeled with a brief explanation. With a maximum of 10 points to be lost.	(0 to 10 points)
An additional 10 points will be awarded to squads who turn in articles, photos etc. to the State Historian for the State Scrapbook prior to August 15th.	(0 to 10 points)
<b>Each scrapbook has the possibility of scoring 100 points.</b>	
Each squad Unit Director at Convention will be given a ballot to cast their squads vote for the People's Choice Award. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be determined by popular vote.
